Overview

ENDANGERED chronicles a year in the life of four journalists reporting inside Mexico, Brazil and the United States - three democratic nations where the view of the press is rapidly deteriorating. As newsrooms shutter around them, misinformation proliferates, and world leaders brazenly suppress free speech, reporters Patrícia, Carl, Sášhenka, and Oliver face harrowing circumstances to make sense of a world out of balance.

Committee to Protect Journalists

World Press Freedom Day

World Press Freedom Day was proclaimed by the UN General Assembly in December 1993, following the recommendation of UNESCO's General Conference. Since then, May 3, the anniversary of the **Declaration of Windhoek** is celebrated worldwide as World Press Freedom Day.
